- 12. Ignore sin. Pastors must address this issue, even when it's not popular.

#### Martin Luther: on Spiritual and Physical Life

## Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to Spirit. – John 3:6

We can't feel the new birth or the spiritual life with our five senses. We can't see it. The spiritual life will endure, while the physical life will one day end. Our lives on earth will eventually become like dust, which is blown away and never be seen or felt again. Then only the spiritual life will remain. We will be raised from the dead and will come alive once again.

We can't see or understand this spiritual birth. We must simply believe it. What is born of the Spirit is spiritual, and the primary benefit of this new birth is the forgiveness of sins and eternal life. Nevertheless, Christians still have an external existence. While they live here on earth, they are nurtured by a mother and father, eat and drink, wear clothes and shoes, have a house and garden, and own money and property. They view all of this as if they were guests who were traveling through this to another city-their true destination. When they arrive there, they will no longer care about the places where they stayed along the way. During the journey, they were always thinking, "Today I am a guest. Tomorrow, I will continue my trip." In the same way, a Christian also thinks, "Today, I am a guest here on earth. I eat and drink here. I live honorably and modestly in this life. But tomorrow, I'll proceed on my way to an eternal life in the kingdom of heaven, where I am a citizen." So Christians also journey through this life. When they come to then end of this life, they will let go of everything physical and enter a spiritual life that will never end.


